This 31st day of March, 1970.

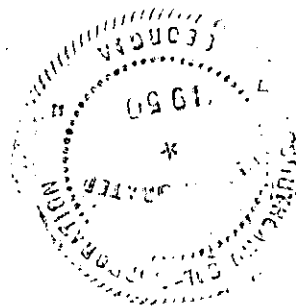
