All those pieces, parcels or lots of land lying, being and situate on the West side of the Greer-Oneal Highway (also known as State Highway no. 101), about three miles Northwest of Greer, in Oneal Township, County and State aforesaid, and being known and designated as lots nos. Five (5), Six (6) and Nine (9) of the S. S. Mason property as shown on plat prepared by J. J. Bruce, Surveyor, dated Feb. 28, 1950 and which plat has been recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County in Plat Book 00, page 547, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit: Beginning at an Iron Pin on the West side of said highway at the joint front corner of lots nos. 6 and 7 as shown on said plat, and running thence with the joint property line of said two lots S.63-30 W.188 feet to an old Iron Pin at the joint corner of lots nos. 6, 7 and 9 as shown on said plat, thence N.67-26 W.270 feet to an old Iron Pin, thence N.63-40 E.184 feet to an Iron Pin at the joint corner of lots nos. 4, 5, 8 and 9 as shown on said plat, thence with the joint property line of lots nos. 4 and 5 N.69-10 E.205 feet to an Iron Pin on the West side of said highway, thence with the West side of said highway S.19-38 E.100 feet to an Iron Pin at the joint front corner of lots nos. 5 and 6, thence with the West side of said highway S.19-00 E.86 feet to the beginning point. Said lots nos. 6 and 9 were conveyed to S. S. Mason by Gay Nelle James by deed recorded in said office in Deed Book 641, page 333. Lot no. 5 was conveyed to S. S. Mason by Robert Tow and Norma Jean Tow Hannigan by deed recorded in said office in Deed Book 660,
