ALL that piece, parcel, or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known as Lot No. 3, Hillside Terrace, and having, according to a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book F, Page 154, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeastern side of Cleveirvine Avenue (formerly Hillside Avenue), at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 3, and running thence with the joint line of said lots N 37-40 E 200 feet to an iron pin; thence S 41-08 E 45 feet to an iron pin in the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 3 and 5; thence with the joint line of said lots, S 29-14 W 169.2 feet to an iron pin in the northeast side of Cleveirvine Avenue; thence with the northeast side of Cleveirvine Avenue N 71-10'W 73 feet to the point of beginning.
