ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS

Hunt -Vice President, duly authorized to act for and on behalf of said corporation, all the right, title and interest of Assignor in and to the rents, issues, revenues and benefits from the property described on Exhibit "A" which is annexed hereto and made a part hereof.

And to that end, Assignor hereby assigns and sets over unto Assignee, its successors and assigns, all leases of said premises now made, executed or delivered, whether written or verbal, including specifically, without limiting the generality thereof, the following described leases:
