THIS RELEASE given by DUKE POWER COMPANY, a North Carolina corporation, having its principal place of business in Charlotte, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina, to EDNA M. ROSS, of Greenville County, South Carolina.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, EDNA M. ROSS is the owner of 40 acres, more or less, on the northern side of Darby Road, near the Mountain Creek Road, in upper Greenville County, South Carolina, as shown on a plat of the Property of the Greenville City Water Works, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book D, page 49, and being more fully described in a deed to Edna M. Ross from M. L. Ross, dated February 26th, 1971, recorded on the same date in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 909, page 455; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Greenville was formerly the owner of said property and used the same as a pumping station to filter waters from the Enoree River as a part of the water distribution for the City of Greenville, which has now been abandoned; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Greenville, during its ownership of said property, granted to Southern Power Company various rights of way, leases, substations sites for the service of said pumping station with electrical current and DUKE POWER COMPANY is the successor in title to all of the assets of Southern Power Company;

WHEREAS, none of said leases, easements or rights of way now serve the property or are actually in existence on the ground.
