ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land, together with buildings and improvements situate, lying and being on the Southern side of Berkley Avenue about three miles from the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot No. 22 on a Plat of the Property of Ethel Y. Perry Estate, dated November, 1947, prepared by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book R, page 127, and being shown on a more recent plat entitled "Property of John N. Mullinax & Kathleen H. BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Berkley Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 21 and 22, and running thence N. 80-52 W., 60 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 22 and 23; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 9-08 W, 132.5 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 26, S. 80-03 E., 60 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 21 and 22; thence with the line of said lots, N. 9-08 E. 133.4 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of Berkley Avenue, the beginning corner.

The above property is the same conveyed to John N. Mullinax and Kathleen H. Mullinax by deed of Moneta S.
