such as entrances, sanitary services common to the units of a particular building, and the like.

"General Common Elements" and "Limited Common Elements" are further defined to mean and comprise all of the real property, improvements and facilities of University Ridge Horizontal Property Regime other than the Units, as the same are hereinabove defined, and shall include easements through the Units, for conduits, pipes, ducts, plumbing, wiring and other facilities for the furnishing of utility service, including television antenna cables, to Units and General Common Elements and easements of support in every portion of a Unit which contributes to the support of improvements, and shall further include all personal property held and maintained for the joint use and enjoyment of all of the co-owners of all such Units.

- (i) <u>Common Expenses</u> means (a) expenses of administration, maintenance, repairs and replacements of the common elements, (b) expenses determined by the Association to be common expenses and (c) expenses declared to be common expenses by provisions of the Act, this Declaration or the By-Laws of the Association.
- (j) <u>Condominium Documents</u> shall include this Declaration, the By-Laws of University Ridge Association, Inc., all other Exhibits attached hereto, the Floor Plans, and all other documents, rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to the authority created herein and in the Act, as said documents shall be amended from time to time.
- (k) <u>Developer</u> means GREERCO, INC., a South Carolina corporation, having its principal office at Greenville, South Carolina.
- (1) <u>Family</u> or <u>Immediate Family</u> shall mean father, mother, son, daughter, brother, sister, wife, husband.
- (m) Floor Plans shall mean those drawings, plats, and schedules entitled Floor Plans of University Ridge Associates, Inc., and any amendments thereto.
- (n) <u>Foreclosure</u> shall include the exercise of a power of sale contained in any deed to secure debt or other instrument conveying security title to a unit.
