ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land near Travelers Rest, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being shown and designated as Tract No. 3 on the Plat of the Property of P. B. Batson Estate prepared by W. R. Williams, Jr., R. E. & L. S. #3979, in October, 1973, and containing 9.87 acres, more or less, and according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a nail and cap in the center of Little Texas Road, joint front corner of Tracts 3 and 4; thence with the center of said road, S. 69-31 E. 90.3 feet to a nail and cap; thence continuing with said road, S. 45-28 E. 60.5 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said road, S. 20-51 E. 100 feet to a nail and cap, joint front corner of Tracts 2 and 3; thence with the common line of Tracts 2 and 3, S. 16-52 W. 1540.4 feet to an iron pin; thence with the common line of Paris Mountain State Park, N. 81-56 W. 154.2 feet to a concrete monument; thence N. 7-30 W. 387.8 feet to an iron pin; thence with the common line of Tract 4, N. 20-43 E. 1335.9 feet to the beginning corner.

This property is subject to a Greenville Water Works right-of-way which contains approximately .39 acres as shown on the plat referred to above.
