the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto GERTRUDE H. BROCK, her heirs and assigns:

ALL OUR UNDIVIDED 2/15THS INTEREST IN AND TO:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in Ocklawm Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being situated on the east side of the original Pelzer Road, and being a lot cut off the southwest side of Rice homestead, bounded on the north and east by land of Rice, on the south by land of Brock, and on the west by King land, and being more fully described by a plat made by J. Max Richardson on November 8, 1952, which shows the following courses and distances to-wit:

BEGINNING at iron pin in center of original Pelzer Road, King and Rice corner; thence along this road S. 41-25 E. 577.5 feet to an iron pin in said road; thence along W. C. Brock line S. 72-00 E. 672.0 feet to an iron pin in center of paved road to Washington Church; thence along new line N. 41-20 W. 48.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 75-02 W. 445.0 feet to the point of beginning in center of original Pelzer Road and containing 4.42 acres, more or less.

ALSO: ALL that other tract of land in Ocklawm Township, county and state aforesaid, containing 2-1/16 acres, more or less, described as follows:

BEGINNING on a stone fx on the Pelzer Road near Washington Church; thence N. 4- E. 7.77 chains to a stone fx; thence N. 80- W. 9.70 chains to a stone fx on the Pelzer Road; thence S. 82- E. 8.00 chains to the beginning corner, being bounded by lands of Sullivan and McDavid.

This being the same property conveyed to W. C. Brock, also known as William Clifton Brock, as shown in Deed Volume 407 at page 71 and Deed Volume 394 at page 370. W. C. Brock, also known as William Clifton Brock, died intestate May 14, 1943 leaving as his heirs at law, his widow, Gertrude H. Brock and nine surviving children to-wit: Emma K. Brock, Rudolph Brock

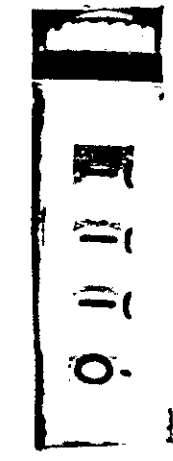
RENUNCIATION OF DOWER
