the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Harold B. Palmer and Catherine S. Palmer, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being at the southerly intersection of East Indian Trail and Indian Circle, near the City of Greenville, S. C., being known and designated as Lot No. 3, on plat entitled "Final Plat Seven Oaks" as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book 4R, at page 6, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwesterly side of Indian Circle, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots 3 and 4 and running thence with the common line of said lots S 38-57 W 177.8 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner of Lots 3 and 4; thence N 9-58 W 15.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N 8-23 W 165.3 feet to an iron pin on the southerly side of East Indian Trail; thence with the southerly side of East Indian Trail N 49-47 E 110 feet to an iron pin the intersection of East Indian Trail and Indian Circle; thence S 49-17 E 11.2 feet to an iron pin on the southwesterly side of Indian Circle; thence with the southwesterly side of Indian Circle on a curve S 23-54 E 114 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

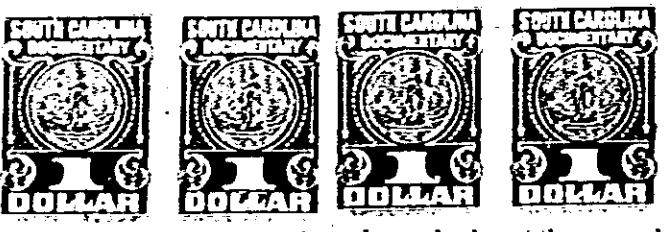
