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all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina being located at the Southwest corner of Gordon Avenue and Link Street, and being known as Lot #1 according to plat of property of Wilkins Norwood by Piedmont Engineering Service dated April 11, 1950, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book X, Page 189, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southwest intersection of Gordon Avenue and Link Street and running thence along the Southern side of Gordon Avenue S. 80-0 W. 46.55 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot #2 S 9-44 E. 87 feet to an iron pin on the line of Lot #3; thence along the line of Lot #3 N. 75-13 E. 63 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Link Street; thence along the Western side of Link Street N. 20-57 W. 84.1 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning.

The above described property is a portion of the same conveyed to the grantor by deed from George Norwood as Trustee dated May 1, 1946, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Book of Deeds 290, Page 446.

The property hereinabove described was conveyed to Aimee Sloan Norwood as Substituted Trustee under terms and provisions of a deed of trust dated January 27, 1943 and said deed of trust being duly recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Book of Deeds 242, Page 191. Reference is made to Judge Roll F-203 in the Office of Clerk of Court for Greenville County and the said Aimee Sloan Norwood was duly substituted as Trustee under the terms and provisions of said trust pursuant to decree of the Court of Common Pleas by Honorable J. Robert Martin, Jr. Resident Judge, dated December 28, 1949. (230-4-52 Out of 230-4-5)
