All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 10, Eastlake, plat of which is recorded in the RMC Office of Greenville County, South Carolina, in plat book "G" page 229, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northeasterly side of East Circle Avenue, joint front corner of Lots 10 and 11; and running thence N. 37-15 E. 148.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 53-22 W. 49.45 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 52-40 W. 153.6 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots 8 and 10 on the northeasterly side of East Circle Avenue; thence along the north-easterly side of East Circle Avenue S. 52-45 E. 90 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

Senter and my sister, Betsy A. Senter. This deed is for the purpose of conveying all my right, title and interest in the within described property to my father, the grantee herein.
