KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that Cecil Morris, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00) to him in hand paid on behalf of the South Carolina State Highway Department, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns released, acquitted and discharged, and by these presents, does hereby release, acquit and forever discharge the South Carolina State Highway Department, its agents, employees and servants of and from all actions, causes of actions, claims, damages or demands of whatever name or nature or any manner arisen, arising or to grow out of the reconstruction and maintenance of File 23.647, Road S-506, (Tract 3), Greenville County, across and adjacent to the property of the landowner. This Release intends to, and does, cover all past, present or prospective damages which might result to be claimed or result from the construction, reconstruction, and maintenance of the subject project, including construction, reconstruction and maintenance of drainage facilities as they now exist.

IT IS FURTHER ACKNOWLEDGED that there is no agreement or promise on the part of the South Carolina State Highway Department to do or admit to do any act or thing not herein mentioned and that the above consideration is in full settlement of any and all damages to the undersigned, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns arising from or out of any and all matters before mentioned.

The Highway Department, in paying said sum of money, does so in compromise of any and all claims, action or causes of action, damages or demands of whatever kind or nature above released and not admitting any liability on account of the same.
