ANTENUPTIAL AGREEMENT

This agreement made this 4th day of June,  
19 75, between James Robert Wilson III of Greenville, South Carolina,  
and Beverly Ann Brabham of Union Springs, Alabama.

WHEREAS, the parties contemplate legal marriage under the laws of  
the State of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, it is their mutual desire to enter into this agreement  
whereby they will regulate their relationships toward each other with respect  
to the property each of them owns and in which each of them has an interest,  
and with respect to matters of alimony, support and maintenance;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promise of marriage  
and in further consideration of the marriage, the parties hereto agree  
as follows:

1. That all properties of any kind or nature, real, personal  
or mixed, wherever the same may be found, which belong to each party,  
shall be and forever remain the personal estate of said party, including  
all interest, rents and profits which may accrue therefrom.
2. That each party shall have at all times the full right and  
authority, in all respects the same as each would have if not married,  
to acquire, use, enjoy, manage, convey and encumber such property as may  
belong to him or her.
3. It is agreed that in case either of the parties desires to  
mortgage, sell or convey his or her right or personal estate, each one  
will join in the deed of conveyance or mortgage or any other instrument  
as may be necessary to make the same effectual.
