

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Northeastern corner of the intersection of Parker Road and Beattie Street and running thence with the Eastern side of Beattie Street N. 6-21 E. 77.9 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 64 and 65; thence with the line of Lot No. 65 S. 83-39 E. 119.2 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of a fifteen root alley; thence with the Western side of said alley S. 6-31 W. 81.9 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Parker Road; thence with the Northern side of Parker Road N. 82-02 W. 121.8 feet to the point of beginning. -C83-183-5-6
