

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that ROY M. WALL and JANELLE K. WALL,

hereinafter called "Grantor" (whether one or more), of the County and State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of FIFTEEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTEEN & 05/100 DOLLARS (\$15,717.05) PLUS THE MORTGAGE INDEBTEDNESS DESCRIBED HEREWITHIN Dollars, to Grantor in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto DUKE POWER COMPANY, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of North Carolina, hereinafter called "Grantee", all that certain tract of land more particularly described as follows:

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All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Western side of Quillen Avenue (formerly Jones Mill Road), near the town of Fountain Inn, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 3 as shown on a plat entitled Belmont Estates prepared by R. B. Bruce, dated May, 1962, and also being known and designated as Lot No. 1 on a plat entitled Belmont Estates, prepared by R. B. Bruce, dated November 3, 1964, and having according to said plats the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Western side of Quillen Avenue (formerly Jones Mill Road) at the intersection of Quillen Avenue and a new-cut road known as Bell View Drive; thence along Quillen Avenue N 68-50 E 31.6 feet to a pin; thence continuing N 18-08 E 92 feet to a pin; thence N 70-26 W 139 feet to a pin; thence N 60-26 W 65.1 feet; thence S 29-30 W 90 feet to a pin on edge of Bell View Drive; thence with said Drive, S 60-27 E 200 feet to the BEGINNING, and BEING the same property conveyed to Grantor by deed of Frederick R. Jones and Shirley M. Jones dated January 2, 1969, and recorded in Book 859 at page 317 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.
