

these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Faris Cahaly and George Cahaly, their heirs and assigns forever, all my undivided one-third (1/3) interest in and to the following described property, to wit:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the North side of Pendleton Street, between Wardlaw Street and the C.& G. Railway Track, known as part of Lot Number one (1) of the lands of the Thomas J. Turner property and having the following metes and bounds: BEGINNING at an iron pin on Pendleton Street, corner of property formerly belonging to W. J. Strawn and running thence with line of this property N 19 1/2 W. 101 feet to stake; thence S. 70 1/2 W. 32.6 feet to corner of lot sold by Jas. M. Richardson T. W. D. Workman; thence along line of said lot S 19 1/2 E. 101 feet to Pendleton Street; thence with Pendleton Street N. 70 1/2 E. 32.6 feet to the beginning corner; together with the right to join on the wall of the building situate upon lot formerly owned by W. J. Strawn. This being the identical lot of land conveyed unto me by Deed of E. Inman, Master and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Volume 221 at page 370, the remaining two-thirds (2/3) of which was conveyed to Faris Cahaly and George Cahaly, by deed dated May 19, 1947, which is also of record in the aforesaid RMC Office in Volume 312 at page 294.
