Jean G. Brewer, her heirs and assigns forever:

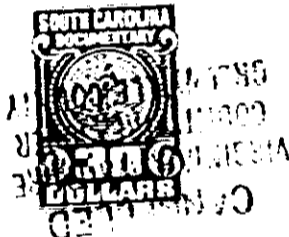
My undivided one-third interest in and to the following described property:
