to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Samuel E. Holder, his heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL of my undivided interest in and to all of that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot No. 4 of W. C. Cleveland property, according to a plat prepared of said property in the year 1908 and which said plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book A, at Page 261, and according to said plat having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of West Park Avenue, at the joint front corner of Lots 4 and 5 and running thence with the common line of said lots, S. 13 1/2 W. 195 feet to a rock wall; thence with said wall in a northeasterly direction, 60 feet, more or less to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 3 and 4; thence running with the common line of said lots, N. 13 1/2 E. 182.5 feet, more or less to an iron pin on West Park Avenue; thence running with said street, N. 76 1/2 W. 60 feet to a point on the edge of said street, the point of beginning. - 500 - 12 - 1 - 4

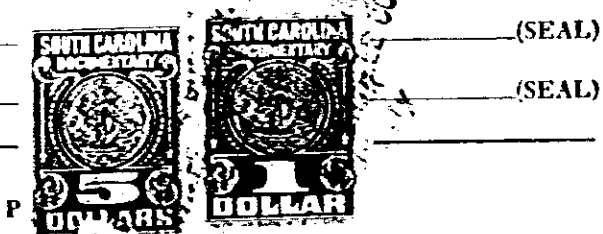
