AMENDMENT TO RIGHT OF WAY
AGREEMENT

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THIS AMENDMENT TO RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT made this 3th
day of October, 1975, by and between Herbert F. Clark, II, and
Transcontinental Gas Pipeline Corporation.

WHEREAS, by Right of Way Agreement executed by J. L.
Brashier, dated July 1, 1949, and recorded in the Office of the
RMC in and for said County in Book 388 at Page 113, (hereinafter
referred to as Original Agreement), TRANSCONTINENTAL GAS PIPE LINE
CORPORATION (hereinafter called Transcontinental) is the owner of
a right of way and easement for pipe line purposes across the lands
described therein situated in Greenville County, South Carolina,
reference being here made to said Original Agreement and its records
for a complete description of the lands involved and all other
purposes; and

WHEREAS, Herbert F. Clark, II, (hereinafter called Grantor),
is the present owner of the lands covered by the said Original
Agreement, and

WHEREAS, Transcontinental has heretofore constructed four
pipe lines across Grantor's said lands in accordance with said Original
Agreement and may in the future from time to time desire to construct
additional pipe lines thereto, and Grantor has requested Transcontinental
to enter into this agreement for the purposes of limiting and defining
Transcontinental's right of way.

NOW, THEREFORE, It is agreed by and between Transcontinental
and Grantor that, insofar as that part of the lands described in the
Original Agreement and presently owned by Grantor are concerned,
said Original Agreement shall be and is hereby amended as follows:

1. Transcontinental's permanent right of way shall
be 152 feet in width, the side lines of same
being located 40 feet northwesterly of and 112
feet southeasterly of and parallel to the center
