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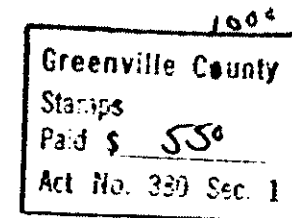
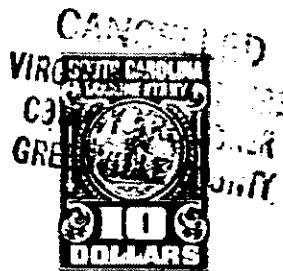
TIMBER TITLE

THIS INDENTURE, made this 29 day of April, 1976,
between William Edward Coble, Jr.
of Greenville County, South
Carolina, party of the first part, and Canal Wood
a corporation organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina, party of the second part,
WITNESSETH:

The party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of \$4,560.00 Dollars, in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has bargained, sold conveyed and by these presents does bargain, sell and convey to the party of the second part, its successors and assigns, all of the PINE AND HARDWOOD timber of every kind and description, both standing and fallen, that will measure at the time of cutting 0 inches and upward in diameter, the long way outside bark at point of severance.

on the following property, to wit:

All that tract or parcel of land lying, situate and being in the Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 68 acres, more or less, and bounded as follows:

on a plat prepared by W. F. Atkins, Surveyor, dated March 6, 1940, which plat is recorded in Plat Book J at Page 197 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

ALSO, all that piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina, Fairview Township, containing 28.05 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake, joint corner of the 68 acre trace and running thence along the joint line, S. 15-30W., 716 feet to a stake; thence S. 75-30 E. 749 feet to a stone; thence S. 34-30 E. 1,216 feet to a stake; thence S. 75-0 E. 1,072.5 feet to a stake; thence N. 0-50W. 111 feet to a stake; thence N. 47-00W. 3,014 feet to a stake, the point of beginning.

This is the identical property heretofore conveyed from Mary Burdette Coble to William Edward Coble, Jr., on August 29, 1974 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 1006, Page 291 and 292, and this timber title is intended to cover all of said property in said deed.

PLEASE NOTE: The below described Section of the above property is where the timbers will be cut, to-wit:

Beginning at north and east sides running with boundary lines to Natural Gas pipe line and thence with pipe line on south side to old fence, with fence on west side to pasture thence with pasture to north boundary line.

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
