- 1. Transfer by Adams. Adams in consideration of One (\$1.00)

 Dollar paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and of the conveyance by the Bank hereinafter agreed to be made, hereby agrees to sell and convey to the Bank, at a valuation, for the purpose of this contract of Six Thousand Forty Five Dollars and No/100 (\$6,045.00). A copy of the form of deed with the legal description contained therein is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.
- 2. Transfer by Bank. The Bank, in consideration of One (\$1.00)

 Dollar paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and of the conveyance by Adams described above agreed to be made, hereby agrees to sell and convey to Adams, at a valuation, for the purpose of this contract of Six Thousand Forty Five Dollars and No/100 (\$6,045.00). The property to be conveyed is to contain 4.03 acres of that certain tract of land more particularly described on Exhibit B attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- 3. <u>Selection by Bank</u>. It is understood and agreed that the 4.03 acres of land to be conveyed to Adams is to be selected by the Bank and to be surveyed at the expense of Adams. The property is to be selected out of 153 acres, more or less, as described on Exhibit B. It is acknow-
