Sherer and running thence along the southerly side of Brookside Way, S. 55° 56' E. for a distance of 79.5' to an iron pin; thence continuing along the southerly side of Brookside Way S. 75° 45' E. for a distance of 95.65' to an iron pin; thence along the line of other property owned by the Grantor S. 05° 04' E. for a distance of 221.6' to an iron pin; thence S. 65° 47' W. for a distance of 109.9' to an old nail and cap; thence N. 23° 29' W. for a distance of 337.53' to an old iron pin; thence N. 66° 43' E. for a distance of 61.58' to the point of beginning, all as shown on a survey prepared by James R. Freeland dated August 11, 1976.

THIS property is a portion of the same property conveyed to the Grantor herein by Deed of Gerry L. Prevost, said Deed being dated April 14, 1976 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 1034 at page 745.

GRANTOR hereby reserves unto himself, his heirs and assigns, forever, a ten feet wide easement over and through the property being conveyed herein, for the purpose of installing and maintaining a four inch sewer pipe line to enable Grantor to tie onto the City of Greenville municipal sewer line. Said easement shall run generally over and along the northerly and northeasterly part of the property being conveyed herein, provided, however, neither the installation nor the maintenance of said sewer pipe line shall interfere with the use and enjoyment of the property by Grantee. Grantor shall be responsible for maintaining said sewer pipe line and shall hold harmless the Grantee from any damages suffered by Grantee as a result of the installation or existence of said sewer pipe line. Said easement shall be deemed as running with the land.
