 South Carolina,

WHEREAS, Piedmont Natural Gas Company, Inc. is the owner  
 and holder of a certain easement over and across lands of Elijah  
 Hawthorne for the purpose of laying, constructing, maintaining,  
 operating, repairing, altering and replacing and removing of pipe  
 lines for the transportation of gas, oil, petroleum products and any  
 other liquid gases and substances which can be transported through  
 a pipe line, said easement being recorded in the office of the  
 Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Deed Book

445, Page 391; and

WHEREAS, the Greenville County Soil Conservation District  
 desires to construct and maintain a flood retarding structure as a  
 part of its program to reduce the hazards of flood damage within what  
 is known as the Hurf Creek Watershed, said structure being more  
 specifically shown on a sketch map designated "Flood Retarding  
 Structure No. 5-3, Hurf Creek Watershed," a copy of which sketch map  
 is recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for  
 Greenville County in Plat Book MM, page 173, and a copy of  
 which is attached to, incorporated into and made a part of this  
 agreement; and

WHEREAS, the construction of said structure will cause the  
 inundation of portions of the pipe line of Piedmont Natural Gas Company,  
 Inc. on its easement over the lands of the above-named land owner; and
