in consideration of FIVE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED & NO/100 (\$5,300.00) ----- Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto THE SOUTH CAROLINA STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, Its Successors and Assigns, Forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, as shown on plat of Paris Subdivision recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, page 211 (also Plat Book C, pages 86 & 87), lying on the National Highway, said lot being known as Lot No. 8, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at iron pin on National Highway at joint front corner of Lots 7 and 8 and running thence N. 54-20 E. 20 feet to iron pin; running thence S. 35-40 E. 39.2 feet; running thence S. 57-56 W. 22.2 feet, joint rear corner of Lots 7 and 8; running thence along joint line of said lots N. 32-16 W. 37.7 feet to iron pin, the beginning corner.

BEGINNING at joint front corner of Lots 16 and 17 and running thence along National Highway N. 54-20 E. 25 feet to joint front corner of Lots 17 and 18; running thence S. 32-40 E. 59.6 feet; running thence S. 57-56 W. 25 feet; running thence N. 32-38 W. 52 feet to the beginning corner.

This property was conveyed a one-half interest to Frances C. Taylor by deed of Louis Henry Cary, et al, June 1, 1953, deed being recorded in Deed Book 479, page 375. The other Grantors inherited this property from Floride S.
