RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT

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APR. 1969

In consideration of the sum of money hereinafter set out and other good and valuable consideration, the adequacy and receipt of which is hereby acknowledged from the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, the undersigned, owner(s) of the premises described below, do hereby grant to the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, its successors, agents, assigns, and allied and associated companies, a right of way easement to construct, operate, maintain, add or remove such lines or systems of communications or related services as the grantee may require, consisting of:

(1) poles, guys, anchors, aerial cables and wires;

(2) buried cables and wires, cable terminals, markers, splicing boxes and pedestals;

(3) conduits, manholes, markers, underground cables and wires;

(4) and other apparatus, poles, structures or devices.

Upon over and under a strip of land 10 feet wide across the following lands in Gv1, County, State of S. C., generally described as follows: that tract of bound on the east by Hudson Road and on the south by the property of Ronald E. and Don Bridgefort as described in Greenville County Property Plats (Pg. 543.10 Block 1)

and, to the fullest extent the undersigned has the power to grant, flat, hill, river, along and under the roads, streets or highways adjoining or through said property.

The following rights are also granted: the right, in any other period or manner, to attach wires or guy cables or conduit within the right of way for communications or electric power transmission or distribution; to ingress and egress to said premises at all times; to clear the land and keep it cleared of all trees, undergrowth or other conduct and within the easement area; to trim and cut and keep trimmed and cut all dead, weak, leaning or dangerous trees or limbs outside of the easement area which might interfere with or fall upon the lines or systems of communication or power transmission or distribution.

the receipt of one and no mill dollars (\$1.00) is hereby acknowledged by the undersigned.

To have and to hold the above granted easement unto Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, its successors and assigns forever.
