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THIS DEED, made and executed by J. ELLIOTT WILLIAMS, as United States Marshal for the District of South Carolina, to FEDERAL DEPOSIT INSURANCE CORPORATION, P.O. Box 11510, Columbia, South Carolina 29211.

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Pederal Deposit Insurance Corporation, as plaintiff, on or about May 24, 1976, filed its complaint in the United States District Court for the District of South Carolina, Columbia Division against MARION M. GANDY and WILLIAM W. GODSHALL, as defendants, in Civil Action No. 76-921 for the purpose of foreclosing a mortgage encumbering the real property hereinafter described;

WHEREAS, after full hearing of the issues, the Honorable Robert F. Chapman, Judge of said Court, on November 3, 1976, ordered, adjudged and decreed that the property hereinafter more particularly described should be sold by the United States Marshal or his duly authorized deputy on the terms and for the purposes set forth in the order;

WHEREAS, I, J. ELLIOTT WILLIAMS, as United States Marshal for the District of South Carolina, acting pursuant to the aforementioned order and also in consideration of the aforementioned sum paid by Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto FEDERAL DEPOSIT INSURANCE CORPORATION and its successors and assigns all of the following real property:

Highway 29, being shown and designated as the vesterly onehalf (1/2) of Lot No. 8 on plat of Property of James Edwards recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book "M", at page 125, and also being shown on a more recent plat entitled "Survey for Arlon O.
