All my undivided one-sixth (1/6) interest in and to:

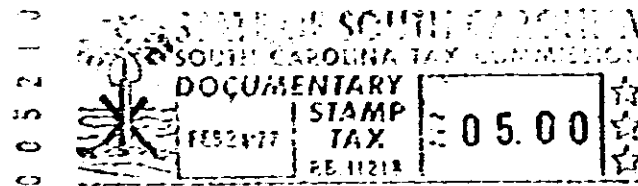
