This matter was before me on the Complaint filed by the Plaintiff in which he seeks to void a contract existing between the Plaintiff and Defendant and was entered into on July 1, 1975. The Plaintiff seeks additional relief to require this Court to direct the Register of Manse and Conveyance to cencel the contract filed in the RFC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 1021, Page 121.

I further find as a finding of fact, that the Defendant was served on October 14, 1976, as will appear by the Affidavit of Service of Steven L. Lindsey, and that no notice of appearance or masswer having been filed by the Defendant or in his behalf as will appear by the affidavit of Plaintiff's Attorney and, therefore, the Defendant is in default.

I further find as a finding of fact that the violation of the terms of the contract existing between the parties in that the Defendant has failed to make payments when due and has not paid any payments since August 1, 1976, and I further find that the Defendant has failed to maintain insurance on the building as required on the aforessid contract.

I further find as a finding of fact, that the Plaintiff is entitled to relief sought in his complaint and that the Defendant has forfacted any rights that he has had in said real estate and contract. It is, therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED: That the Register of Mense and Conveyance of Greenville County, S. C., is hereby directed to cancel the contract of record existing between the parties which is recorded in Deed Book 1021, Page 121, and said contract is null and void as it relates to any interest that Defendent has in said real estate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That any rights that the Defendant has in the contractorecorded in Deed Book 1021, Page 121, is hereby declared null and void.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
