gain, sell and release unto the said Grantee(s), the following described property situated in the county of

GREENVILLE South Carolina, to wit:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being near the
City of Greenville, County of Greenville, South Carolina, being known as
LOT 364 on a plat of SECTION 2, ABNEY MILLS, BRANDON PLANT, and recorded
in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in PLAT BOOK QQ, at PAGES 56-
59, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds,
to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Mason Street, joint front
corner of Lots 364 and 342, S. 46-0 E. 127.1 feet to an iron pin; thence
S. 44-0 W. 88.5 feet to an iron pin on Woodward Street; thence along with
said street, N. 46-0 W. 113.3 feet to an iron pin; thence around a curve,
the chord of which is N. 0-42 W. 21.2 feet to Mason Street; thence with
Mason Street, N. 44-36 E. 73.5 feet to the point of beginning.
