FOURTH: The parent corporation agrees that it may be served with process in the State of South Carolina to enforce any obligation of the subsidiary corporation for which the subsidiary corporation was previously subject to suit in the State of South Carolina, or of any obligation of the parent corporation for which the parent corporation was previously subject to suit in the State of South Carolina, as provided in the Business Corporation Act of the State of South Carolina. The parent corporation hereby irrevocably appoints the Secretary of State of the State of South Carolina as its agent to accept service of process in any such proceeding. The post office address within the State of South Carolina to which the said Secretary of State shall mail a copy of any process in such proceeding is:
