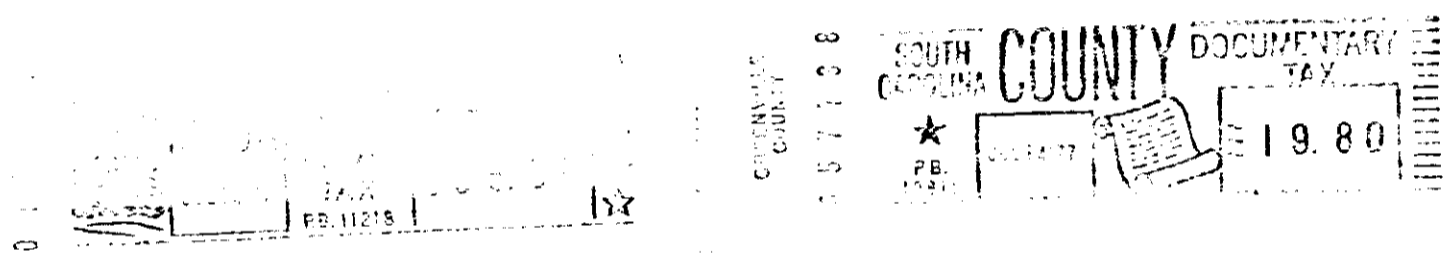
All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, situate, lying and being at the southeastern intersection of Ackley Street and Celand Street and being known and designated as Lot No. 4 of the Property of J. G. Cely, plat made by J. Coke Smith in August, 1939, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the southeastern intersection of Ackley Street and Celand Street and running thence with the eastern side of Celand Street, S.36-05 E. 200 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 5; thence with the line of said Lot in a northeasterly direction 66 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 3; thence with the line of said Lot in a northwesternly direction 200 feet to an iron pin on Ackley Street; thence with the southern side of Ackley Street, S.65-15 W. 84 feet to the point of beginning.

This conveyance is subject to all restrictions, setback lines, roadways, zoning ordinances, easements and rights-of-way appearing on the property and/or of record.
