law relating to the sell of land of a decedent; and the party of the second part is to pay all taxes, assessments or impositions that may be legally levied or imposed upon the land subsequent to the year 1976 and in case of failure of said Thomas Sloan party of the second part to make either of the payments or any part thereof, or to perform any of the covenants on his part, hereby made and entered into, this contract shall, at the options of the parties of the first part, be terminated, and payments made by the party of the second part shall be taken to be in payment of rents for said premises and for damages sustained by the parties of the first part; and such payments shall be retained by the said parties of the first part in full satisfaction and in liquidation of all damages by them sustained, and for the rental value of said premises, and the said parties of the first part shall have the right to re-enter and take possession of the premises aforesaid without being liable to any action therefor, or he may retain the amount paid and also require specific performance of this contract.

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED by and between the parties hereto, that the time of payment shall be an essential part of this contract, and that all covenants and agreements herein contained shall extend to and be obligatory upon the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of the respective parties.
