Trust Estate shall reax in in tact and no distributions thereof shall be made to anyone, unless as hereinabove provided for the payment of insurance premiums.

Nothing herein is intended to limit the power of the Trustees to invest and reinvest the Trust principal according to the broad powers granted them under the FIFTH paragraph of this instrument.

(B) At the death of the Grantor, the Trustees shall distribute free of trust out of the Trust Estate, a total amount of no less than Six Thousand (\$6,000.00) Dollars and no more than Ninety Thousand (\$90,000.00) Dollars (or property of such value), the exact amount of distribution between these two figures to be determened by the Trustees, to Grantor's children share and share alike. If any child of grantor shall at such time be deceased leaving a living spouse, such spouse shall receive a portion equal to one-third of the portion which such child would have been entitled to if living. The balance (two-thirds portion) of the share which such child would have received if living (or the entire) share if there be no living spouse) shall go to the living issue, if any, of such child; those issue who are the children of such child to take equal amounts, a living parent to exclude his children, and the children of a deceased parent to take equally a per stirpes amount. If any child of Grantor shall at the time of said distribution be deceased without leaving issue living, the amount (twothirds portion or full share) which such issue would have received if living shall be added to the amount distributable as hereinabove provided to Grantor's other children or their spouses and/or their issue.

(C) From the date of the death of the Grantor, the Trustees shall make monthly payments of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars from the income or principal or both of said Trust Estate to Francis R. Fant, Attorney, so long during the duration of this Trust as he shall be willing to render legal advice and services in respect to the administration of this Trust.
