John Scott Robertson and Gail C. Robertson, their heirs and assigns forever,

ALL that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being on the Northeast side of Snow Road in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being shown and designated as Lot #13 on Plat of Section Two, Woodmont Estates, made by C. O. Riddle, RLS and recorded in the Greenville County RMC Office in Deed Book 5D at Page 70 and having, according to said plat, the following description:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the right of way of Snow Road, joint front corner of lots 12 and 13; and running thence with the line of lot 12, N. 43-55 E. 400 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 71-20 E. 193.5 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots 13 and 14; thence with the line of lot 14, S. 43-55 W. 482.5 feet to an iron pin on Snow Road; thence with the right of way of Snow Road, N. 46-05 W. 175 feet to the point and place of beginning.

And, the grantor(s) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's heirs or successors, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the grantee(s) and the grantee's(s)' heirs or successors and assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s)' heirs or successors and against every person whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
