WHEREAS, by deed dated March 22, 1973 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 972 at Page 83, Peoples National Bank, Greenville, S. C., as Trustee for Estate of Roger S. Huntington, deceased, conveyed an undivided one-eighth interest in and to the property therein described and

WHEREAS, it subsequently appeared that said deed contained an error in the description and that it is now the parties' intention and desire to reforem the description contained in said deed, NOW THEREFORE,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT Bankers Trust of South Carolina (successor by merger of Peoples National Bank, Greenville, S. C.) as Trustee for the Estate of Roger S. Huntington, deceased, in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of One and 00/100----- Dollars  
(\$1.00) and correction of deed

to it paid by Fred M. Huntington

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and quitclaim released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell/and release unto the said FRED M. HUNTINGTON, an individed one-eighth interest:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the East side of River Street in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Eastern side of River Street N. 27-30 E. 78 feet from the corner of Hammond Street and running thence with River Street N. 27-30 E. 62.6 feet to an iron pin in the center of the C & WC railroad siding; thence with the center line of said siding S. 61-45 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 27-30 W. approximately 62.4 feet to the outside or Northern edge of the wall of a brick building; thence with the outside or Northern edge of the wall of said building N. 62-23 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the identical property conveyed to R. S. Huntington and DuPont Guerry, Jr., by deed of Huntington & Guerry, Inc., dated July 1, 1927, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Deed Volume 132, at Page 202.

ALSO, all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, at the Northeastern corner of Hammond and River Streets and having according to a plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, dated December, 1926, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Northeastern corner of Hammond and River Streets, and running thence with River Street N. 27-30 E. 78 feet to a point in a brick wall, which point is the Northwestern corner of said brick wall; thence along the Northern edge of said brick wall S. 62-23 E. 100 feet to an iron pin at the edge of said wall; thence N. 27-30 E. 62.4 feet to an iron pin in a railroad crosstie, the center of the C & WC Railroad siding; thence along the center of said siding S. 61-45 E. 85.3 feet to an iron pin, the center of a ten foot party alley; thence with the center line of said party alley S. 41-49 W. 143.05
