KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, ROY A. LOCKABY, and We, JOHN W. LOCKABY &amp; ZADIE LOCKABY,

in consideration of THREE THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$3,000.00) -- Dollars.

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto CARROLL BURRELL &amp; CONNIE BURRELL, Their Heirs &amp; Assigns, Forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land with all improvements thereon or hereafter constructed thereon situate, lying and being in County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing 3.2 acres more or less according to a survey made by W. R. Williams, Jr., Engineer, November 23, 1977, and having according to said plat the following courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINNING at iron pin at drive at corner of 4.1 acre tract and other property of Roy A. Lockaby and running thence along Lockaby property S. 53-51 E. 110.8 feet to iron pin; running thence S. 33-53 E. 265.7 feet to iron pin; running thence S. 40-51 E. 114.9 feet; running thence S. 10-12 E. 155 feet; running thence S. 50-19 W. 230.5 feet to iron pin; running thence N. 55-34 W. 194.5 feet to iron pin; running thence along joint line of 3.2 acre tract and 4.1 acre tract N. 0-38 E. 554.4 feet to beginning corner.

The Grantor does hereby grant to the Grantees, their heirs and assigns, a right to use a 20-foot driveway for five years and at the end of five years, regardless of who is the owner of the 3.2 acre tract, the right to use said driveway is terminated and voided; and that by the acceptance of this easement or right of way the Grantees agree to the same for themselves and their successors in title.

The within property is sold subject to any and all existing and recorded easements, rights of way and restrictions affecting said property.

This being a portion of the property conveyed to Roy A. Lockaby by John W. & Zadie Lockaby, who held a life interest therein, as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County Oct. 3, 1973 in Deed Book 985, page 417 and a portion of the property conveyed by deed recorded in Deed Book 993, page 216 on Nov. 19, 1974. IT IS the intention of John W. & Zadie Lockaby to convey any interest they have in the above property, whether fee simple or life estate. In consideration of the above mentioned instruments of conveyance, it is agreed that in any way incident or appertaining to the above described property, the grantor and the grantee, their heirs and successors and assigns forever, shall be entitled to the quiet enjoyment of the same free from all encumbrances, covenants, restrictions, taxes, assessments, liens, claims, debts, demands, judgments, suits, actions, controversies, and administrates to warrant and fully defend the same against all persons, the grantee's heirs and successors and against every person who may ever lawfully claim the same.
