EASEMENT AGREEMENT

F. A. and Julia P. Hightower to
Sloan Construction Co., Inc.

All that certain piece of land in O'Neal Twp. Greenville County,
State of South Carolina lying on the east side of R.C. State Highway No. 283
near Sandy Flat and containing One and 28/100 Acres, more or less and having the
following Metes and Bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on Stokes line on the east side of Highway No. 283
formerly known as the Greer to Tigerville Road and running thence N.32-00 E.
80 feet to point in old road; thence N.1148 W. 26.8 feet to iron pin, corner
of the William Parker Tract; thence N.62-24 E. 268 feet to iron pin about 80
feet east of Spring; thence N. 26-15 W. 180 feet to an iron pin; thence N.72-24 W. 313 feet to iron pin 28 feet from center of Highway on R.O.W. line
thence with R.O.W. Line S. 24-48 E. 280.7 feet to beginning corner.
