That BANKERS TRUST OF SOUTH CAROLINA, as successor Trustee under the Will of Clinton J. Morgan, hereafter referred to as Grantor, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, paid to Grantor by Clinton J. Morgan, Jr., hereafter referred to as Grantee, at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Grantee, CLINTON J. MORGAN, JR., his heirs and assigns forever:

All its right, title and interest, the same being an undivided one-half (1/2) interest, of, in and to:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land lying, being and situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, about four miles north of the City of Greenville, near Paris Station.
