TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

WHEREAS, Clinton J. Morgan, of Greenville, South Carolina, died on November 19, 1935, leaving of force his Last Will and Testament dated June 14, 1929, and codicil dated January _____, 1930, on file in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Apartment 456, File 4; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of said Will the property herein-after described was devised to the Peoples National Bank of Greenville, S. C., for and during the life of his wife, Virginia M. Morgan, and thereafter in trust for his son, Clinton J. Morgan, Jr., until said son reached the age of 35 years, at which time the trust was to cease and determine; and

WHEREAS, the said Virginia M. Morgan died on November 4, 1949, and the said Clinton J. Morgan, Jr., attained the age of 35 years on June 10, 1958; and

WHEREAS, Peoples National Bank of Greenville, S. C., was merged with Bankers Trust of South Carolina, the grantor herein, on the 15th day of October, 1973, and said Bankers Trust of South Carolina succeeded the said Peoples National Bank of Greenville, S. C., as Trustee under the Will and Codicil of Clinton J. Morgan, hereinabove referred to;

NOW, THEREFORE, in order to confirm fee simple title to the property hereinafter described in the said Clinton J. Morgan, Jr.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That BANKERS TRUST OF SOUTH CAROLINA, as successor Trustee under the Will of Clinton J. Morgan, hereafter referred to as Grantor, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, paid to Grantor by Clinton J. Morgan, Jr., hereafter referred to as Grantee, at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Grantee, CLINTON J. MORGAN, JR., his heirs and assigns forever:

All its right, title and interest, the same being an undivided one-half (1/2) interest, of, in and to:

ALL that certain lot of land situate in Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot #8 of subdivision of lots of W. D. Parrish at "Paris" as shown on plat recorded in RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "E", page 46 and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pipe on the west side of Mooney Road at corner of lot #7 and running thence with Mooney Road, N. 32-42 W. 20 feet to a stake, corner of Lot #9; thence with line of lot #9, S 57-18 W 101.5 feet to a stake; thence S 30-42 E 12.3 feet to an iron pipe; thence S 36-43 E 10 feet to a stake, corner of lot #7, thence with line of lot #7, N 56 W 98.8 feet to the beginning corner.
