AGREEMENT

COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this Standard day of May, 1978, by and between BRUCE R. DUNCAN, hereinafter called Seller, and SILAS N. EPPS AND CASSIE EPPS, hereinafter called Purchasers, whereby it is agreed as follows:

That the Seller agrees to sell unto the Purchasers the property hereinafter described for the consideration of Eight Thousand Four Hundred and No/100
(\$8,400.00) Dollars plus the Purchasers presently assuming that certain mortgage
given by the Seller and his former wife to Blue Ridge Production Credit
Association in the original amount of Sixteen Thousand and No/100 (\$16,000.00)
Dollars, said mortgage recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C.,
in Mortgage Book 1330 at Page 893, and being dated February 24, 1977; that as
further consideration, the Seller does hereby agree to render to the Purchasers
the sum of One Thousand Three Hundred and No/100 (\$1,300.00) Dollars, when the
note is paid off, said amount being the approximate pro-rata balance of the bond
given by the Seller to the Blue Ridge Production Credit Association at the outset of the loan.

The Purchasers further agree to pay all real estate property taxes, assessments or other levies on the property. The Seller, however, reserves the privilege to anticipate or pay all the real estate property taxes, assessments or other levies on the property prior to maturity without penalty.

The property, which is the subject of this Agreement, is described as follows:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being on the northwesterly side of a county road in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing 25.35 acres, according to a plat of property of Bruce Duncan prepared by Terry T. Dill, dated September 15, 1971, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book SSS, page 468, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
