Spartanburg Street State and County aforesaid, as shown by plans prepared by the City of Greenville on and over all land which I (or we) own and are furtherdescribed below, for the purpose of locating, constructing improving, and maintaining the above described highway with the bridges and causeways thereon, and the right to construct and maintain controlled access facilities to said bighway:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the corner of Mt Zion Avenue and Church Street joint corner of Lots Nos. 24 and 25 and running thence with the line of Lot No. 25 N. 86½ W. 108.5 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on alley; thence with alley N. ½ E. 25 feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence S. 86½ E. 108.5 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on Mt. Zion Avenue; thence with Mt. Zion Avenue S. 3½ W. 24 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.
