KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT We, E. C. Bailey, Sam Burts and John C. Winn, as Trustees of Enoree Presbytery and as Trustees for the Executive Committee on Home Missions for Enoree Presbytery in consideration of the premises have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Presbytery of the Piedmont, incorporated under the laws of South Carolina, its successors and assigns forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel, or tract of land, with any improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, on the western side of Poinsett Highway, at the northwestern corner of the intersection of Poinsett Highway and Cope Circle as that intersection is shown on a Final Plat of Cope Heights prepared by J. C. Hill, R.L.S., and Fletcher C. Tate, Associate, dated December 1, 1962, and being described more particularly as follows:
