Spartanburg Street State and County aforesaid, as shown by plans prepared by the City of Greenville on and over all land which I (or we) own and are furtherdescribed below, for the purpose of locating, constructing improving, and maintaining the above described highway with the bridges and causeways thereon, and the right to construct and maintain controlled access facilities to said highway:

Shockley Said property is described as follows: Lying and being in the County and State aforesaid about one mile East of the Court House at Greenville, just East of Richland Creek, said lot is known as No. (1) No. One on plat made by F. C. Rogers on Feb. 17, 1911. Said lot fronting on Church Street and lying next to the R. R. Cut, as fully shown on said plat.

Said right-of-way is described as follows: Beginning at a point on the Northwestern side of Spartanburg Street at the joint front corner of Lots 1881-8-8 and 188.1-8-7 and running thence in a northeasterly direction along Spartanburg Street 75 feet, wore or less, to the intersection of Spartanburg Street and a railroad cut 75, said easement/shall contain any and all portions of the above-described property between the baseline and a line designated proposed right-of-way shown on a plat prepared by W.
