ALL that certain piece, parcel or strip of land located, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and shown on plat entitled "Road Location for Max Rice, Sheets Nos. 1 and 2" dated May 6, 1977, prepared by Carolina Surveying Company, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book 6-C at Pages 46a 47 said strip being an unnamed road on the northern side of South Carolina Highway No. 11, 50 feet in width except as otherwise shown on said recorded plat, said road having the metes and bounds as shown on said plat, reference to which is hereby craved for a more complete and accurate description, said road running a linear distance from a point in the center line of S. C. Highway No. 11 a total of 6,557.9 feet.
