in consideration of -- Pive Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$5,500.00)----- Dollar,

the seceipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have grasted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Perry D. Lupo and Kathryn H. Lupo, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 116 of an Addition to Section 1 of Stone Lake Heights as shown on plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service in November 1956, recorded in the R.Y.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book W, at page 86, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Lotus Court, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 115 and 116, and running thence along the joint lire of said lots S. 24-59 3. 152.91 to a point in a creek, the distance between iron pins being 137.91; thence following the center of said creek as the line, a traverse line being N. 67-48 E. 118.8', to a point in said creek, the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 116 and 117; thence along the joint line of said lots N. 26-26 W. 158.7' to an iron pin on the Southern side of Lotus Court, the distance between iron pins being 143.71; thence along the Southern side of Lotus Court S. 65-01 W. 115' to the beginning corner.

This conveyance is subject to drainage and utility easements which appear of record and to a 40° building setback line as shown on the recorded plat. The lot is also subject to restrictions and protective covenants identical to those imposed upon Section 1 of Stone Lake Heights by instrument dated November 7, 1952 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 466, at page 279, as said covenants may have been subsequently amended.

The above described property is a portion of the same conveyed to the late E. E. Stone and the late Agres O. Stone by deed recorded in the R.K.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. PPP, at Page 157. The said Agnes O. Stone died in or about the year 1918, leaving a will wherein she devised her interest to her husband T. C. Stone. The said T. C. Stone died in the year 1955, leaving a will wherein the bulk of his estate was devised to certain trustees under a testementary trust. The grantors, Sugene E. Stone, Jr. and Alexander H. Stone are trustees under an inter vivos trust created by the trust agreement above mentioned and recorded in the R.K.C. Office in Deed Book 1026, page 24, called Stone Enterprise Trust. The grantors Hallie S. Maxon and Ann S. Cleveland join in the conveyance to satisfy a requirement of the Stone Enterprise Trust that 55% of the beneficial owners express their consent to a sale.
