

That no default be made in the performance of any of the terms hereof or no default be made in any payment of principal or interest on any notes hereof hereafter signed by the undersigned, the undersigned agrees and does hereby assign the rents and profits arising or to arise from said premises to the bank and agrees that any judge or court or any other authority may at chambers or otherwise appoint a receiver of the described premises with full authority to take possession thereof and collect the rents and profits and hold the same subject to the further order of said court, but agrees further that the bank shall have no obligation to perform or discharge any obligation, duty or liability of the undersigned in connection with the said assignment of rents and profits.

4. That no default be made in the payment of loans and indebtedness hereunder or the performance of any of the terms hereof. Bank at its election may declare the entire remaining unpaid principal and interest of any obligation or indebtedness then remaining unpaid to Bank to be due and payable forth with.

5. That Bank may and is hereby authorized and permitted to cause this instrument to be recorded at said time and in such place as Bank may determine hereof.

6. Upon payment of all indebtedness of the undersigned to Bank this agreement shall be and become void and of no effect and upon the date of such payment and the undersigned, their heirs, legatees, devisees, administrators, executors, successors and assigns, and heirs to the benefit of Bank and its successors and assigns. The absence of any notice of payment made to Bank showing any part of said indebtedness to remain unpaid shall be and constitute conclusive evidence of the validity, effect, force and continuing force of this agreement and any person may and is hereby authorized to rely thereon.
