This is the same property conveyed to R. B. Tindall by Greenville Cemetery Association, December 28, 1916, and recorded September 27, 1919 in the R.M.C. Office of Greenville County in Deed Book 29, at Page 376. R. B. Tindall died testate in November, 1941, devising the above conveyed property to his three children, Stella Tindall, Thomas R. Tindall and Wynona T. Bell. Stella Tindall died intestate on August 16, 1978, leaving as her sole heirs at law the grantor and grantee herein.
