interest of the Grantor. In determining the competency or ability of the Grantor to look after his own affairs, the Trustee may, at any time, conclusively rely upon the written opinion of any doctor at any time treating or looking after the Grantor.

- 4. Upon the Grantor's death, the Trustee shall pay all remaining corpus and undistributed net income to the Grantor's executor or administrator to be held or distributed as a part of his estate.
- 5. The Grantor reserves the power to revoke the trust in its entirety, or to alter or amend any terms or provisions hereof in any way, by an instrument in writing filed with the Trustee; provided, however, that the duties, powers and liability of the Trustee hereunder shall not be substantially changed without written consent of the Trustee. Upon the delivery to the Trustee by the Grantor of such an instrument, this trust agreement shall be deemed to have been revoked, altered or amended in the manner and to the extent therein set forth.
- By way of illustration and not of limitation and in addition to any inherent, implied or statutory powers granted to trustees generally, the Trustee is specifically authorized and empowered with respect to any property, real or personal, at any time held under any provision of this Trust, to allot, allocate between principal and income; assign, borrow, buy, care for, collect, compromise claims, contract with respect to, continue any business of the Grantor; convey, convert, deal with, dispose of, enter into, exchange, hold, improve, incorporate any business of the Grantor; invest, invest in any collective trust fund of the trustee; lease, manage, mortgage, grant and exercise options with respect to, take possession of, pledge, receive, release, repair, sell, sue for and in general, to exercise all of the powers in the management of the Trust Estate which any individual could exercise in the management of similar property owned in his own right, upon such terms and conditions as to the Trustee may seem best, and to execute and deliver any and all instruments and to do all acts which the Trustee may deem proper or
