This is a sample form made of the general template above, where the terms and conditions have been made clearer, so that it is much easier to read, and notes provide more fine-grained control over what the user sees and does. It also assigns the rights and costs of using each service to the service providers, so that the terms and conditions are clear and unambiguous, and makes it easier to enforce accountabilities around the use of specific services without having to go through the process of changing the terms and conditions and then the service provider to the user's needs. The notes further make the code much more modular and easier to maintain.
